



## Laminate Surfaces

Tables with laminate surfaces are covered in high pressure laminate. High pressure laminate is extremely durable, and it is the perfect choice if you want a table that is easy to maintain. Be aware that there may be subtle differences in shine between the surfaces, as well as minor pigmentation spots (no more than 0.5 mm).

### How to extend the life of your laminate furniture

Here are a few tips that will extend the life of your beautiful laminate surface. First of all, we recommend regular daily cleaning of the surface with a damp cloth. It is important for the cloth to be placed in hand-warm water and wrung out thoroughly. Finally, wipe the surface with a clean, dry cloth.

If you want a more thorough cleaning, you can add a few drops of mild detergent for each quart of water. Next, wipe the surface with a damp, clean cloth to remove any remaining detergent. Finally, wipe the surface with a clean, dry cloth.

If you are getting ready to the ultimate cleaning of a laminate surface, you can clean the table with a grease-cutting detergent that contains no scouring agents. To avoid discoloration, you must follow up by wiping off the detergent with a cloth placed in clean water and wrung out thoroughly. Finally, wipe the table with a dry, clean cloth. Avoid using harsh cleaning products on wooden edges, and instead wipe with a cloth placed in clean water and wrung out thoroughly. Subsequently, wooden edges should also be wiped off with a clean, dry cloth.

In order to avoid scratching the laminate or making it matte, it is important to avoid using nylon sponges or scouring powder when cleaning the surface.

### Accidents happen

If you accidentally got stray marks, grease, oil or other stains on your laminate surface, please keep reading. You can remove the stain using a solvent, acetone, or cleaner's naphta. Make sure the solvent is not applied to any wooden edges. Next, use a cloth placed in clean water and wrung out thoroughly to wipe the surface. Finally, wiped off with a clean, dry cloth. It is imperative that you never use cleaning agents containing wax, acids, or furniture polish, as these are prone to cause discoloration of the surface.
